- Provide a safe and non-judgmental space for members to express themselves openly and honestly.
- Ensure members are respecting others and no one member occupies the majority of a coaching session.
- Give attention to all members and follow-up with participants after your meeting.
- Summarize at the end of session action items or perspectives to explore.

## Goal Setting and Action Planning:

- Collaborate with members to set realistic and achievable goals based on their aspirations and values.
- Support and hold members accountable for their progress, offering guidance and encouragement throughout the coaching journey.

# Empowerment and Motivation:

• Inspire and motivate members to embrace positive changes and face challenges with resilience and determination.

- Help members recognize and leverage their strengths to overcome obstacles and achieve sustainable growth.
- Provide resources and tools to support members in enhancing their personal development and well-being.

# Build and Maintain Relationships:

- Foster trust and confidence in the confidentiality of discussions.
- Collaborate with different coaches and facilitators.
